Customer Profile

The Water Pollution Control Center services all of Canton, Ohio. They have been an LE customer since 1993.

Application

The City of Canton WPCC uses a Walker Process clarifier to separate solids from water. It is in operation approximately 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Challenge

While using a commercial grade gear oil in their clarifier gearboxes, an oil drain and change was required every six months. The reason for the frequent oil changes was due to water contamination and the subsequent oil-water emulsion it formed. Without a 6-month oil change, they were faced with premature wear and possible gearbox failure which resulted in costly downtime and labor costs. Their goal was to use a gear oil that separated from water allowing the water to be drained out of the gearbox. Plus, they wanted to achieve extended oil drain intervals.
