Custom Compost, Inc. grinds leaves, vegetation and tree stumps in a tub grinder, they then pile it up in rows to decompose. The product is then mixed with sand to make topsoil. They serve the lower Hudson Valley area of New York. They have been using LE products since 1998.

# **Application**

They use a 580 Case backhoe to run various jobs.

### Challenge
