This Montana hydro-electric operation controls more than 11,000 megawatts of generating capacity in the United States, sells energy in key U.S. markets, and delivers electricity to about four million customers.

Application

Francis hydro-electric fixed blade runner turbines and L&S governors.

Challenge

The operation's previous lubrication system was built with 350-gallon tanks for the turbines and governors and had a 4,000-gallon reservoir. This was a lot more oil than needed; the power generator supervisor and project manager wanted a smaller system.

Knowing that the oil could see temperatures as high as 200°F (93°C) with a new lube system, they also wanted to use a superior turbine oil.

LE Solution

The local LE lubrication consultant helped design and install a new lubrication system with a maximum capacity of 150 gallons, reducing the amount of oil needed onsite and reducing the plant's environmental impact.
